Business Partner Committee The purpose of the Business Partners Committee is to develop and plan events to enhance the business partners' experience in the Chapter. Open to business partner members only.

Craft Beer Night – assists staff in planning the Craft Beer Night in the summer.

Education Services: This committee is responsible for formulating, implementing and coordinating the Chapter's education seminars, including Morning Educational Programs, those seminars held at the Trade Shows, and the Essentials programs.

Golf Classic: This committee is responsible for coordinating the annual Golf Tournament.
